

## General Conditions

The event will be run under Pony Club Horse Trials Rules 2010. Competitors are deemed to know the rules and any infringement will incur elimination. By entering this event, competitors have agreed to be photographed by the professional photographer whilst competing.

- ❖ A riding hat must be worn correctly fastened when mounted. All hats must conform to PC standard PAS 015:1998 or BS EN 1384:1997 or EN1384:1996; they should be tagged (available on the day). It is highly recommended that a jockey skull is worn for Cross Country riding.
- ❖ Body Protectors and Medical Armbands must be worn by all competitors on the Cross Country phase.
- ❖ Objections in writing, with a deposit of £10, accepted according to Pony Club Rules.
- ❖ Dogs must be kept strictly under control and on a short lead at all times.
- ❖ All vehicle parking must be within the designated area, not on the verges. Please do not leave litter or skip out boxes.
- ❖ It is not permitted to ride elsewhere. Any competitor or their associates found elsewhere will be eliminated from the competition and any prizes forfeited.

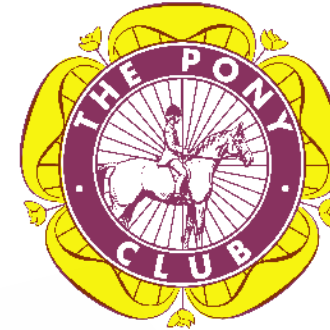
### LEGAL LIABILITY
