

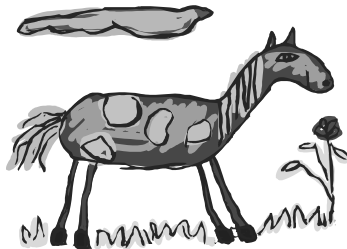
GENERAL CONDITIONS

The event will be run under Pony Club Horse Trials Rules 2007. Competitors are deemed to know the rules and any infringement will incur elimination. By entering this event, competitors have agreed to be photographed by the professional photographer whilst competing.

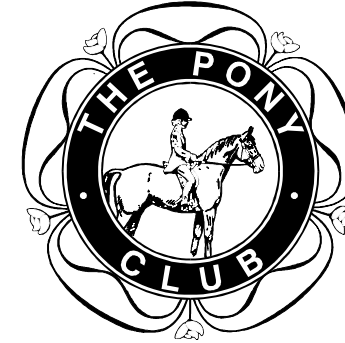
- ◇ A riding hat must be worn correctly fastened when mounted. All competitors must wear a hat that conforms to the Pony Club hat rule (rule 11) and tagged with a Pony Club hat tag. (It must bear the CE mark and a quality symbol, either the BSI Kitemark, the SAI Global symbol or the official Snell label with number)
- ◇ Body Protectors and Medical Armbands must be worn by all competitors on the Cross Country phase.
- ◇ Objections in writing, with a deposit of £10, accepted according to Pony Club Rules.
- ◇ Dogs must be kept strictly under control and on a short lead at all times.
- ◇ All vehicle parking must be within the designated area, not on the verges. Please do not leave litter or skip out boxes.
- ◇ It is not permitted to ride elsewhere in the Park. Any competitor or their associates found elsewhere will be eliminated from the competition and any prizes forfeited.
- ◇ Please note the Park is open to the general public and whilst we take all care to steward the course, we cannot be held responsible for the general public's actions.
- ◇ For dress and tack rules, please visit the Pony Club website and look under appropriate discipline (www.pcuk.org)

Combination of rider and pony/horse not to have been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd in ANY One Day Event
Height of fences approximately 2'
Dressage Test: Pony Club Introductory Test 2007
To be ridden in a snaffle bridle only and can be commanded

Class 3 NOVICE MEMBERS
Genuine Novices please and combination of rider and pony/horse not to have been placed 1st 2nd or 3rd in ANY One Day Event. Height of fences approximately 2'6"
Dressage Test: Novice Dressage Test 2004
To be ridden in a snaffle bridle only, commanders not permitted

Class 4 OPEN MEMBERS
Height of fences approximately 2'6".
Dressage: Novice Eventing Test 2006
To be ridden in a snaffle bridle only, commanders not permitted

Class 5 TEAMS OF FOUR
Two members from the first two classes and similarly, two from Classes 3 and 4. Best three scores to count.
Entries on the day

Please Note: the Cross Country phase is ridden over a Working Hunter type course and knock downs are not penalised.

- ◇ In order to give as many children as possible a chance to compete, second ponies will only be accepted at close of entries, if entries permit, and then in date order of entry received. Please specify first pony choice on entry form and supply two cheques. Telephone on 6th October between 7 and 9 pm to confirm if second pony has been accepted.
- ◇ Entries close 1st October 2007. No entry fee will be refunded after close of entries without a veterinary or doctor's certificate.

- ◇ The XC course may be walked on the day. The SJ course for classes 1 and 2 should be walked before 11am.
