

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The event will be run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2008.
2. Objections must be lodged in writing to the organiser with £10 deposit.
3. There will be no refund for withdrawal of entry after the closing date.
4. Only the designated practice fences may be jumped.
5. Competitors must be correctly dressed and wear gloves for the Dressage Phase.
6. An effective Body Protector must be worn for the Cross Country Phase.
7. All participants must wear a Pony Club Tagged hat whilst mounted. We will provide a tagging service for hats not already tagged. The BE tag does NOT avoid the need for the Pony Club tag. Please see Pony Club Rule Book 2008 for full details of acceptable hats.
8. Ages to be taken as on 1st January 2008
9. Medical Armbands must be worn for the Cross Country Phase
10. Pony Club competitors who have not passed the full Pony Club B Test may only wear spurs if they have the written permission of their District Commissioner. ie signed PC membership card. Please bring this in case of inspection.
11. Stop watches are not allowed for the Cross Country Phase.
12. The organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or change classes or cancel any class if insufficient entries are received for that class.
13. Save for the death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the Organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible neither the organisers of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club nor any agent employee representative of the bodies accepts any liability for any accident loss damage injury or illness to horses riders spectators land cars their contents and accessories or any other person or properties whatsoever whether caused by their negligence breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever.
